

## **Forest Kiwanis 50/50 Draw - May 2021 Lic #821384**

The series of MONTHLY 50/50 draws will take place as follows:

All ticket will only be sold to people who are 18 years of age or older. Purchasers will be required to confirm this via e-mail. Purchasers must be in the province of Ontario at the time of purchase - Purchasers will be required to confirm this via e-mail.

If purchased by the 10th of each month tickets are 3 for \$10; 40 for \$20, 100 for \$40. If purchased on or after the 11th of each month, tickets are 3 for \$10; 20 for \$20, 50 for \$40.

Tickets will be available at a local store for physical purchase pending the end of the lockdown

Tickets will be sold direct-to-purchaser via mail/email or via a Kiwanis Club Member.

Email ticket inquiries to ([info@kineto.ca](mailto:info@kineto.ca)). Inquiries will be returned with a confirmation e-mailed with their 50/50 registered numbers once payment has been received. The original paper tickets can be picked up at a later date.

The winning ticket number will be selected by a random draw from a drum at the home of the ticket issuer (Sally Hoskin) 105 King Street East, Forest, ON N0N 1J0. Two other Kiwanis members will be present to witness (at a social distance). Draw will be video recorded, and photo taken of selected ticket.

Tickets will be sold beginning at 9:00 am on first day of month, and ending at 11:59 pm last day of each month. All tickets purchased by the 10th of each month will be entered into the early bird prize (\$500) draw. All tickets purchased will be entered into the grand prize draw. It is possible for the same number to win both the early bird prize and the grand prize. The draw for the early bird prize (\$500) will take place the following day (11th of each month) at 9:00 am. The grand prize draw (50% of ticket sales proceeds) will take place the first day of the following month at 9:00 am. Each month new draw tickets will be used..

The amount of the 50/50 jackpot will be available and updated daily at [www.Kineto.ca](http://www.Kineto.ca)

The winner will be contacted by a member of the Kiwanis club via telephone or e-mail. The winner will be required to present themselves at an agreed upon time and place to receive their cheque for the amount posted on the website. Winners must have the original winning ticket or e-mail confirmation and winner photo id. All prize payments will be made by cheque. The winning ticket holder has 6 months in which to claim their prize from the date of the draw their ticket was purchased. Once the winner is verified, and provides identification with photo ID, they will be given a cheque in the amount of the declared prize which is, at minimum, 50% of the total sales for that draw. If the winner cannot provide photo ID, then the winning proceeds will be held until such identification can be provided. In the event that no winner comes forward, the winning stub will be kept in a safety deposit box and held for 6 months. After that period of time has elapsed, the prize will be donated to a local charity with the approval of the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO).

The following individuals are not eligible to participate in the 50/50 draws:

- All Kiwanis/Kineto Theatre employees and their immediate families (spouses, parents, adult children, brothers, and sisters)
- Organization Executive or Board members.
